GCSE Geography Trip to Hornsea – Tuesday 22 May 2018

As part of the GCSE Geography course we will be taking the year 9 and 10 students on a fieldtrip to Hornsea on Tuesday 22 May 2018 where they will be conducting a variety of geographical investigations on the beaches and in the town itself.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school at 8.30am and hopefully returning before the end of the school day, however in the event of a possible delay, it would be advisable to make alternative arrangements to collect your child if they catch the school bus.

Students are permitted to wear their own clothes, however need to ensure they wear sensible outdoor clothing appropriate to the weather and suitable footwear for the beach and walking. They will also be required to bring a packed lunch and water bottle. If your child is in receipt of free school meals their lunch will be provided by the school. In addition your child will also need to bring their pencil case and a small amount of spending money is permitted in case of need, however no more than £5 is suggested.

The only cost for this trip is for transport and we are asking for an £11 donation (£7 if you child is in receipt of free school meals) to contribute towards travel expenses. Payments can be made online through the iPay system or cheque, please make cheques payable to Nottingham Free School.
