**Geography & Science Field Trip to Nottingham University Highfields Park**  
**Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2017**

As part of the Nottingham Free School geography and science curriculum we need to undertake field work and on Thursday 29 June we will be taking the year 7 students to Nottingham University Highfields Park to conduct this work.

For geography we will be looking at microclimates and assessing different areas of the site. For science we will be undertaking a study of different habitats and learning different scientific sampling techniques. Field work is an integral part of geography and science and students need to learn how to conduct and present their findings in these subjects, this content will be examined in Year 8.

Students will need to wear sensible outdoor clothing, dependent on the weather and will be required to bring a packed lunch. If your child is a recipient of free school meals then their lunch will be provided by the school. We shall be departing school at 9:30am and arriving back at school at approximately 3:30pm. To cover the cost of transporting the students and hiring the expertise of the park rangers, we are asking for a voluntary £5 contribution, or £2.50 if your child receives free school meals.

It is of vital importance that all students conduct themselves appropriately outside school and show respect towards members of the public. We also expect all students to follow staff instructions to ensure health and safety procedures are followed.
