Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

In preparation for their Spanish GCSE examinations, Year 10 students will be carrying out mock assessments in reading, writing and listening during the week commencing Monday 29 January 2018. These assessments will be based on Modules 1-5. Over the past few weeks the students have been preparing and memorising the work required to do well in these assessments.

The speaking exam, based only on Module 5, will be taking place on **Thursday 15 February** and your child will be allocated a time slot of approximately 10 minutes.

You can support your child by encouraging them to memorise their questions and answers which have been prepared in their books and on flash cards, memorise the key phrases in the revision booklet, as well as Module 5 vocabulary from the Year 10 vocabulary booklet.

They should aim to practise several times a week, little and often. Students will not be permitted to bring any support material into the exam, but they will have a few minutes at the start to make some notes.

Students will receive feedback and a point score overall, which will contribute to their point score for their next report. Re-sits will not be permitted, as we would like the students to experience GCSE conditions.
