


Forgotten Bromcom Student Portal password


Send reset email

and then they will enter the following details:

School ID –11555

Email – usually this is their school email address

Once they have entered this information, click 'Send reset email'




The Student should then receive a success message stating that a password reset email has been sent.

They will then receive an email from Bromcom with a link that they will need to click on, enabling them to reset their password.

Note: The link only lasts for 15 minutes before it expires. If it expires, please follow the steps above to send another email with a new link.

This will take Students to the next step where they will enter a **Password** of their choice.

Note: When creating the Password, it must contain all of the following.



A weak example would be Password1\$


A strong example would be PaS5W0rd_\$

The student should then back to the original **Login Page** where they would now enter the following details and press **Login**:

School ID – 11555

Username – Unique to each Student

Password – Unique to each Student, they have just reset this in the previous steps
